We will keep information about you that is on paper in locked cabinets



We will be careful with information about you and tell you what we are doing with it.

We will only ask for information that we need and we will keep this in an organised way



We will not keep information about you any longer that we need it



We will only use your information for the reasons we have asked for it



We will safely destroy or delete information about you that we don't need




We will make sure your information is right and keep it up to date

We will share information with other people if it is needed to keep you safe

Who does the Information about me belong to?



The information we have about you belongs to you. However the person who looks after you will be responsible for this until you are old enough to look after it yourself.



If you have any questions about your information please speak to your teacher or the person who looks after you at home. They will also be given a notice to tell them about the information we keep about you.
